## Ashland to increase prices on several paint and coatings additives

(NYSE: ASH) will increase global prices by 5 percent for its Aquaflow™ nonionic synthetic associative thickeners; Strodex™, Dextrol™ and Zenix™ phosphate ester surfactants; Advantage™ and Drewplus™ foam control agents; and *pHLEX*™ pH neutralizers. The increases are effective October 1 or as contracts allow.
